Player Code of Conduct

- If players do not follow the Code of Conduct they may be required to apologise to team mates / opponents / officials and could potentially be dropped / substituted from the team
- Whilst staying away, players must follow all rules including own room rules and sleeping times

Parent Code of Conduct
