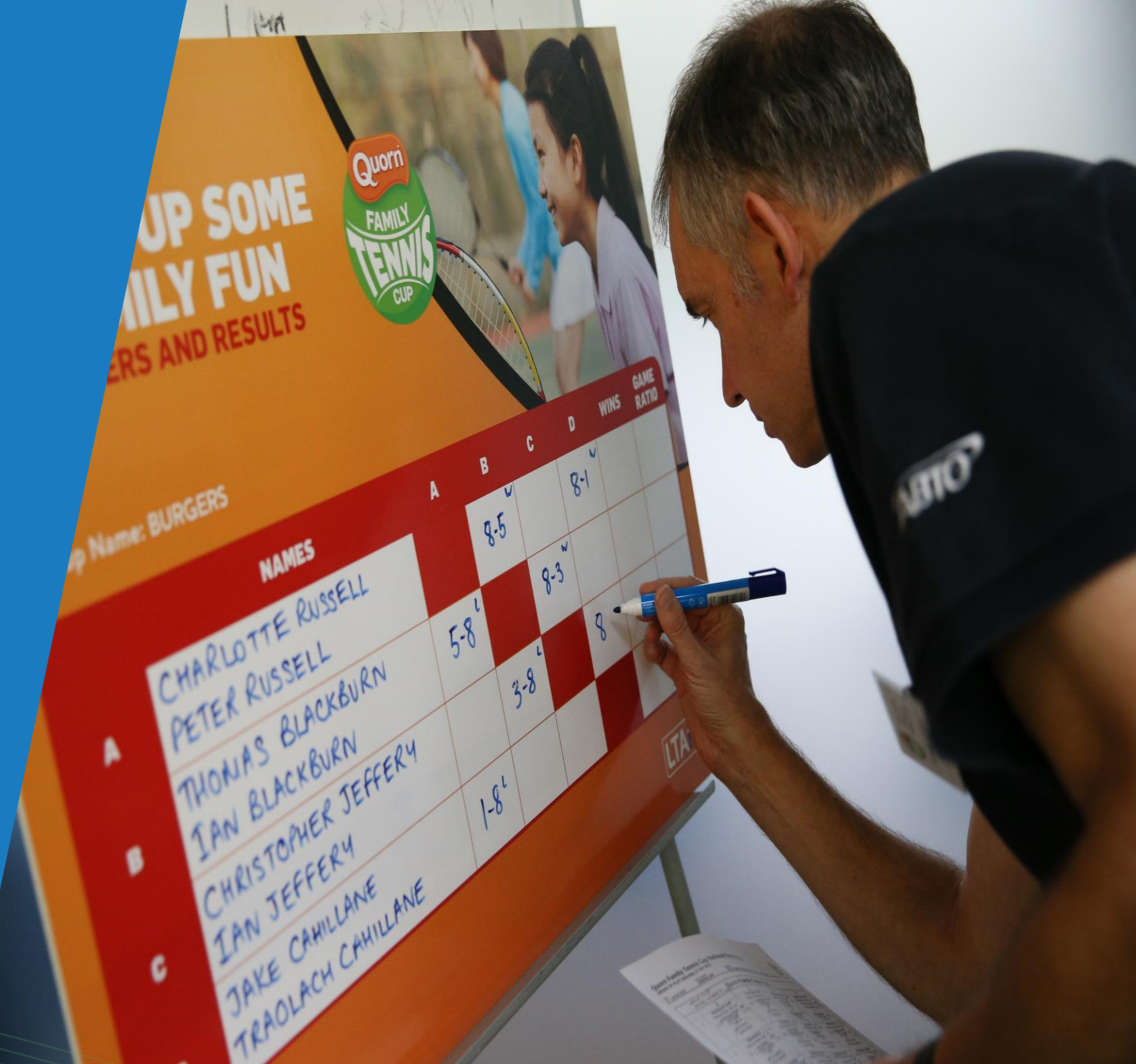

BASIC TENNIS TOURNAMENT PLANNER (TTP) TRAINING SESSIONS FEBRUARY & APRIL

Aimed at Officials and Competition Organisers who have recently qualified, or those who require a basic refresher, these training sessions will show you the fundamental basics of TTP, how to get your events from the Competition Management System into a live TTP file, and help you to avoid common mistakes. We will walk you through event set up, player validation, draws and everything you need to know from start to finish. Each session will last for 2 hours and attendees will receive 2 Officials Licence credits.

NATIONAL REFEREE COURSE

MARCH & OCTOBER

The National Referee Course is a two-day course for R4 Referees to expand and develop their knowledge and experience to enable them to referee at national level tournaments.

By the end of the National Referee Course attendees will:

- Have a solid knowledge of the ITF Rules of Tennis and LTA Competition Regulations
 - Be confident in handling on court situations
- Have the skills to create a tournament plan & schedule for a multi-day & age group tournament at grade 3
- Have a good knowledge of LTA County Cup Rules & Regulations
 - Use TTP and League Planner confidently when officiating

These online sessions will bring together organisers and officials who deliver weeklong Grade 3 competitions.

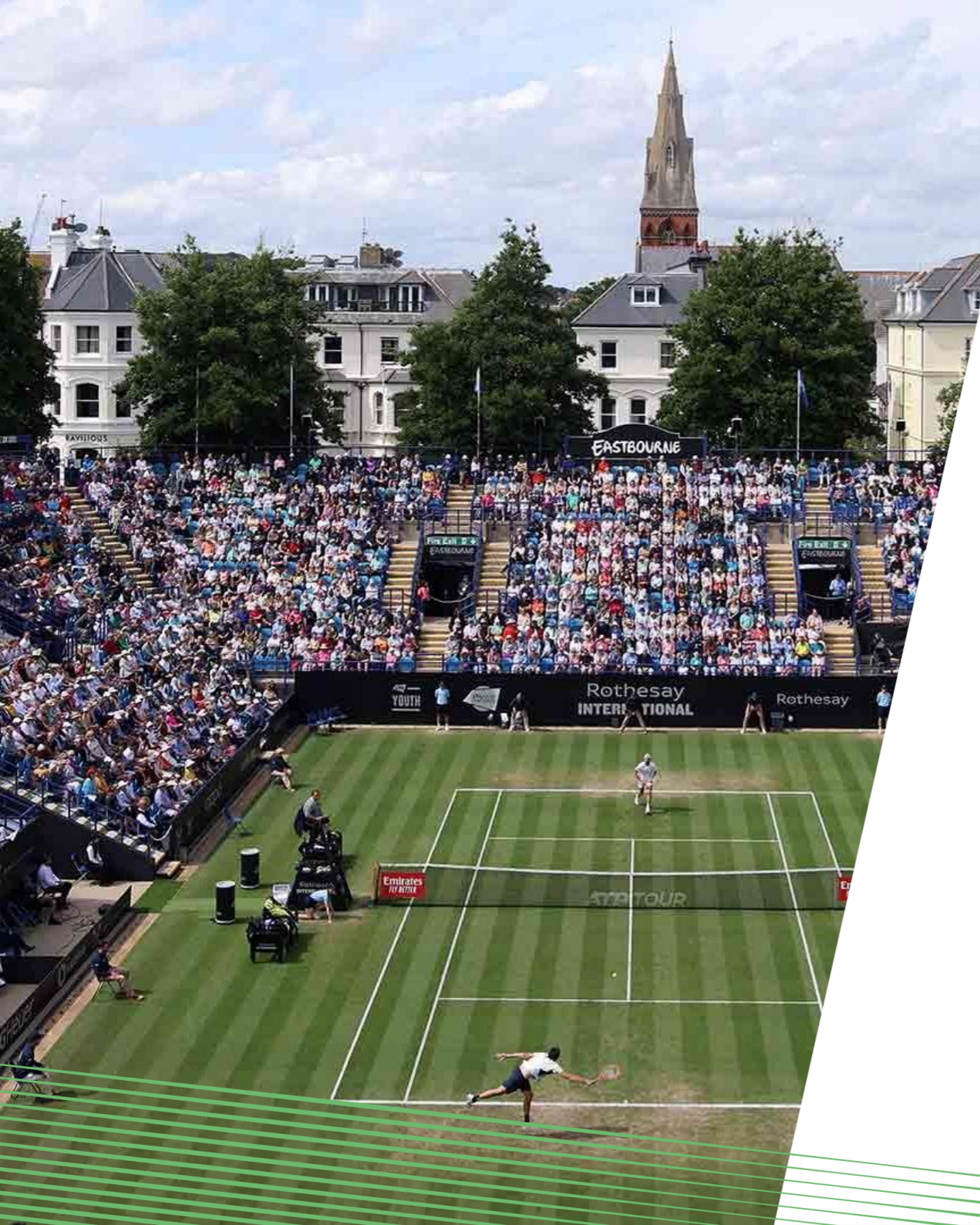
The sessions will be run by CDPs who will present important developments and information in preparation for the Summer season. Organisers and officials will also be able to share ideas and best practice with one another.

REFEREE COURSE

SPRING & AUTUMN

If you are currently a Court Supervisor or Competition Organiser but would like to become a referee you will need to complete our two-day Referee Course.

The course will cover the rules of tennis, code of conduct, refereeing duties, handling on-court situations, and tournament organisation and experience.

At the end of the course you'll have to complete a short exam, and then once you pass you'll be able to referee and organise Grade 4, Grade 5 and Grade 6 competitions.
